What's it like in the interview?

During your interview, you'd be asked a few questions by a researcher from the University of Manchester, who is independent from 42nd Street.

Your answers are confidential, and you don't have to turn on your camera or microphone if you don't want to. There's even an option to take part by WhatsApp/Zoom text chat. It will last up to an hour, but you're free to stop at any time.



You have the option to be interviewed by a co-researcher, who is a young adult with experience of the services at 42nd Street. It is completely optional (although our co-researchers are trained to interview and very friendly!)
